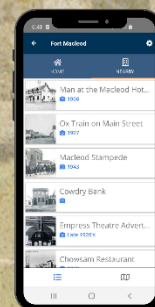

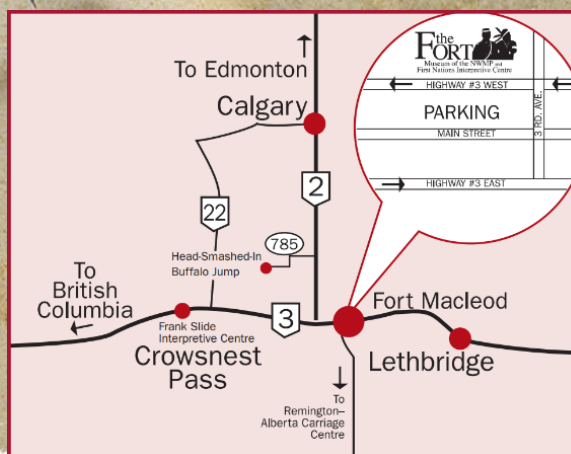


Located near UNESCO World Heritage Sites

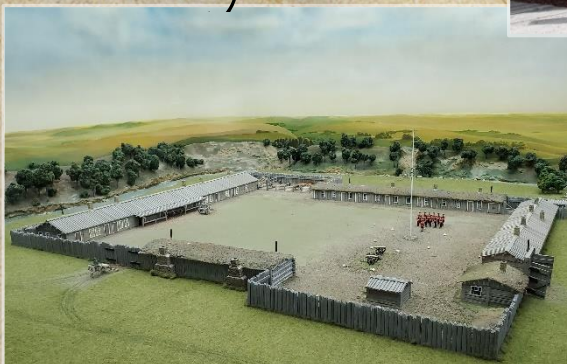
