Park Highlights

- Writing-on-Stone / Áísínai'pi is a spiritual and sacred landscape for Blackfoot First Nations people
- One of the best collections of pictographs and petroglyphs on the North American Great Plains
- Guided tours into a restricted area reveal authentic rock art, history and First Nations culture
- Visitors can hike amongst the hoodoos and discover breathtaking vistas of the rugged badlands
- A full-service Visitor Centre, picnic area, sandy beach, and campground offer additional options

Tours

For individuals, families or small groups (12 persons or less), join our scheduled guided tours into the Archaeological Preserve. Daily tours run from mid-May to the end of September.

The Rock Art in Áísínai'pi and longer Rock Art Tour are walking tours. Here, you can seize the opportunity to see part of the largest concentration of rock art on the Great Plains of North America. Knowledgeable interpreters share Blackfoot oral traditions about the rock art that have been passed down through generations; learn who made these images, why they were made and their cultural significance today.


